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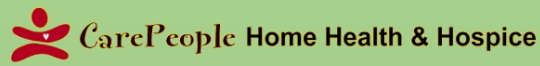

Hospice care services are provided by a team of health care professionals who maximize comfort for a terminally ill person by reducing pain and addressing physical, psychological, social, and spiritual need. To help family, hospice care also provides counseling, respite care and practical support.

Unlike other medical care, the focus of hospice care isn't to cure underlying disease. The goal of hospice care is to support the highest quality of life possible for whatever time remains.

Hospice care for a terminally ill person who's expected to have six months or less to live. This doesn't mean that hospice care will be provided only for six months, however. Hospice care can be provided as long as the person's doctor and hospice care team certify that the condition remains life – limiting.

Medicare A and/or Medicaid will cover hospice care 100%

You and your family members are the most important part of the team. Your team may also include some or all of the following people:
